
Action taken report for the teachers of all departments

Action taken

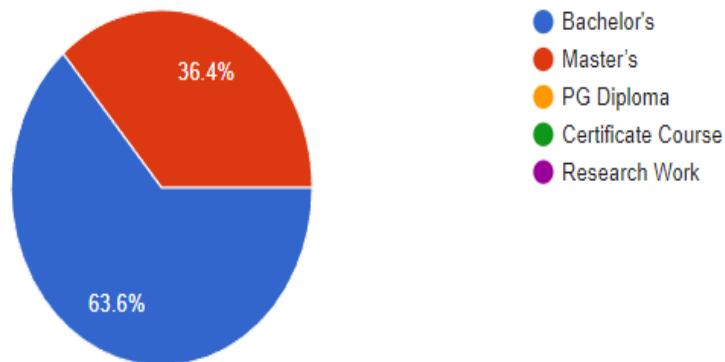
